Instructions for Operation and Care of Model A-120 Hobart Mixer


CONNECTIONS All machines except those phase current are furnished with a flexible cord and attachment plug. Before plugging into a socket the first time make sure that the current and voltage of the motor agree with those of your line. The electrical specifications of the motor are stamped upon the name plate attached to the left side of the case. The outlet 4 is tapped for 1/2" conduit, which may be substituted for the flexible cord if a more permanent installation is required. The planetary must revolve in the direction of the arrow in the illustration.

LUBRICATION The transmission gearing is packed

with a special grease that will last for several years. When grease is needed for replacement it should be ordered from us. A small oiler at 5 is for lubricating attachments. Oil only when an attachment is in place

and never use more than a drop or two. Lubricate the bowl slideways 6 occasionally by applying a very small amount of oil or grease with the tip of your finger. Only mineral oils are suitable for this type of lubrication. The polished drip cup 7 is a safeguard to prevent lubricant that might work out of the planetary gearing from dropping into the bowl. Take it off once a month and wipe it clean. To remove the drip cup, pull it straight down.

speed can be changed by merely turning the speed handle to the desired number; if the load is heavy enough to make the handle turn hard, switch off the motor before changing speed. In the illustration the handle is set for number 3 or high speed. This speed is recommended for fast, light work such as whipping cream, beating eggs, and mixing thin batters.




Number 1 or slow speed is for heavy mixtures, like breakfast rolls. It is also the proper speed for the meat chopper. In many mixing operations it is customary to start on number 1 and then change to a higher speed as the work progresses.

BOWL LIFT Pull the lever 8 forward to lower the bowl. It is necessary to lower the bowl in order to change beaters, and it makes the bowl more accessible for filling. When raising the bowl move the lever a little beyond the vertical center, until you feel it touch the stop. To mash potatoes, or to cream butter, start with the bowl down and raise it slowly into working position.

BEATERS The beaters illustrated in the illustration are as follows:

Style "B" is commonly used for thin batters, cakes, and for mashing potatoes.



Style "D" is best for whipping cream, and beating eggs.

Two other styles frequently used are "E" for heavy bread doughs, and "PK" for cutting shortening into flour for pastry.

ATTACHMENTS Any of our No. 12 size attachments will fit this mixer, the

most popular being the vegetable slicer and shredder, the meat chopper, the fruit juice extractor, the salad oil tank, and the colander. Before putting an attachment into the socket stop the motor, then insert with a slight twist toward the left so that the stop stud in the attachment is tight against the side of the hole that receives it. When in place tighten thumb screw 9 and put a drop of oil in cup 5.

The attachment drive has three speeds, governed by the speed handle of the mixer. For most attachments set the handle at number 1. The tool grinder may run at number 3 speed. THE CHOPPER ATTACHMENT MUST NEVER RUN FASTER THAN SPEED 1 when cutting meat, but when cutting vegetables it may run at number 2 speed. Use the motor switch to start and stop attachments, and always stop the motor before changing the speed of an attachment.

care of motor Motors for certain electrical specifications have removable cover plates at 10. If your machine has such a motor, have a service man take the covers off once a year and inspect the commutator, at which time brushes may be replaced if necessary and the commutator may be cleaned.

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
